Supplies for all students to **keep**:

- three-ring binder (1 ½" - 2")
- 1 wooden ruler with inches and centimeters (not less than 12")
- 1 extra fine point black Sharpie
- pens and #2 pencils
- 1 pkg. notebook divider tabs (science)
- 1 flash drive
- 1 pkg. markers (optional)

Supplies to be **turned in to your social studies teacher**:

- 14 spiral notebooks (70 – 90 pages, not multi-themed)
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener
- 1 pkg. Crayola colored pencils (at least 12)
- 1 pkg. Crayola crayons (at least 24)
- 3 packs (100 each) **lined** 3x5 index cards
- 4 rolls ¾" Scotch tape (preferably with a refillable plastic dispenser)
- Graph paper (turn in half to **math** teacher)
- 1 full-size, sharp pair of scissors (7th graders only)
- 2 **large** rolls of paper towels (7th graders only)
- 1 box of zip-lock type bags – any size (7th graders only)
- 1 family size box of tissues (8th graders only)
- 15 – 16 glue sticks (8th graders only)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (8th graders only)

Math Calculator **Requirement** (also used in science):

- Pre-Algebra (Math 2 Adv) – simple, 4-function calculator with $\boxed{+/-}$ key and $\boxed{\sqrt{\quad}}$ key
Look for Texas Instruments **TI-108**.
- Algebra 1 and Geometry (Pre-AICE 1 and 2) – Texas Instruments **TI-30X IIS**
This is a scientific calculator (approximate cost \$12 – \$15).
